Artistic portfolio 2025

My work takes the form of projects composed of photographic series, videos, and notebooks. These projects seek to highlight the heroic dimension of beings and places as a silent way of resisting, inhabiting, and persisting in the world. The aim is to reveal the discreet transcendence, the memorial charge, or the invisible dignity that certain gestures, certain presences, and certain territories conceal. I use a 4x5-inch camera and medium-format digital equipment to establish, from the moment the picture is taken, a relationship of tension and listening between the camera, the subject, and myself. These tools force me to slow down, to be precise, to pay a kind of attention that becomes almost ritualistic—a way of entering into a vulnerable relationship with reality.

The artistic gestures I propose focus on built and living heritage: minorities, places of memory, vernacular culture. Through them, I seek to recount the territory, its morphology, its history, its emotional and memorial significance. This transcendence of a condition that I am attempting to develop does not consist in magnifying reality, but in revealing its latent power: that “greater than oneself” that germinates in every existence, in every trace, in every stone.

The use of three media—photography, video, and notebooks—allows me to weave a polyphonic reading of reality. This intertwining of forms opens up a space where the gaze, memory, and speech can dialogue and complement each other to bring out the heroic potential of our human positions—that fragile and stubborn impulse that drives us to form societies.

Artisans

For two years, I explored the world of exceptional artisan workshops, capturing rare skills and profound human stories. Discreet but always inspiring, they work with a sense of urgency and imperative necessity, embodying an unbreakable link between tradition and innovation. They are more than their gestures, their tasks, and their actions: we are beyond the act of making. They are the heroes of a world where the sacred still has its place. Their work redefines craftsmanship as a living heritage, diluted in the present. Fearing their disappearance, I photographed them solemnly, as symbols of trust, fragility, and power.

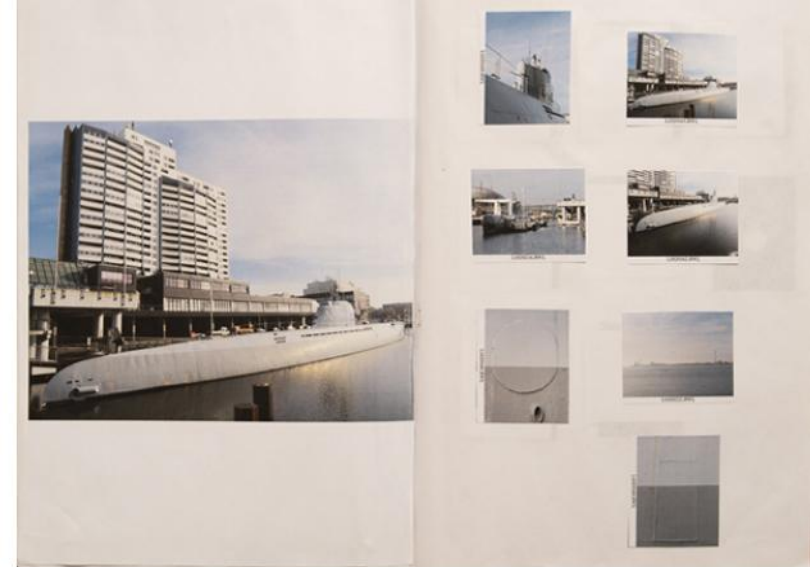
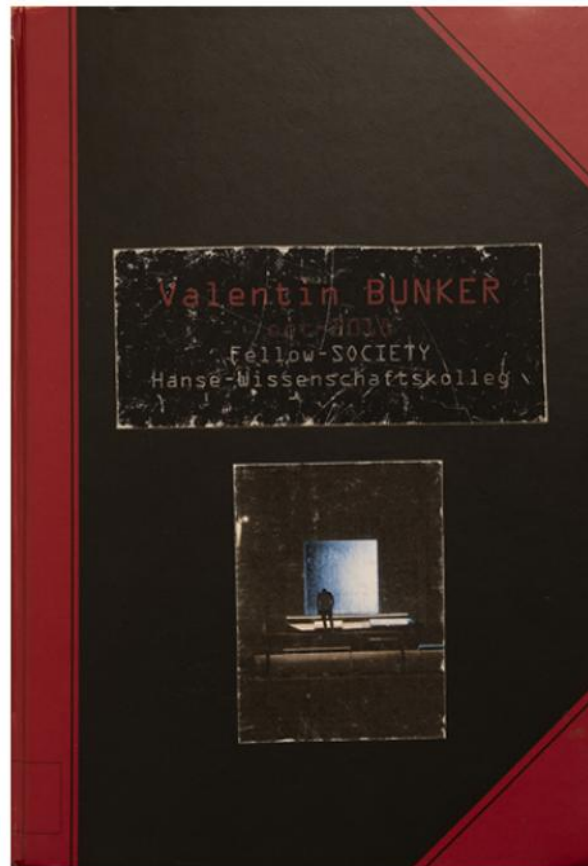

BkV project - Chapter 2

The spectral remains of history. 1,600 forced labourers died on the construction site, the bodies of some of them mixed into the concrete; I felt as though the walls were speaking to me, and I translated this communication into images in an aesthetic, non-narrative experiment.

It reveals my experiments with colour combinations in images, but also my fears about manipulating images. I share it with the project participants. It is a workbook in which instinct frees up mistakes and opens up other possibilities. Most of the images will never be used anywhere other than in the notebook.

Wool from the North

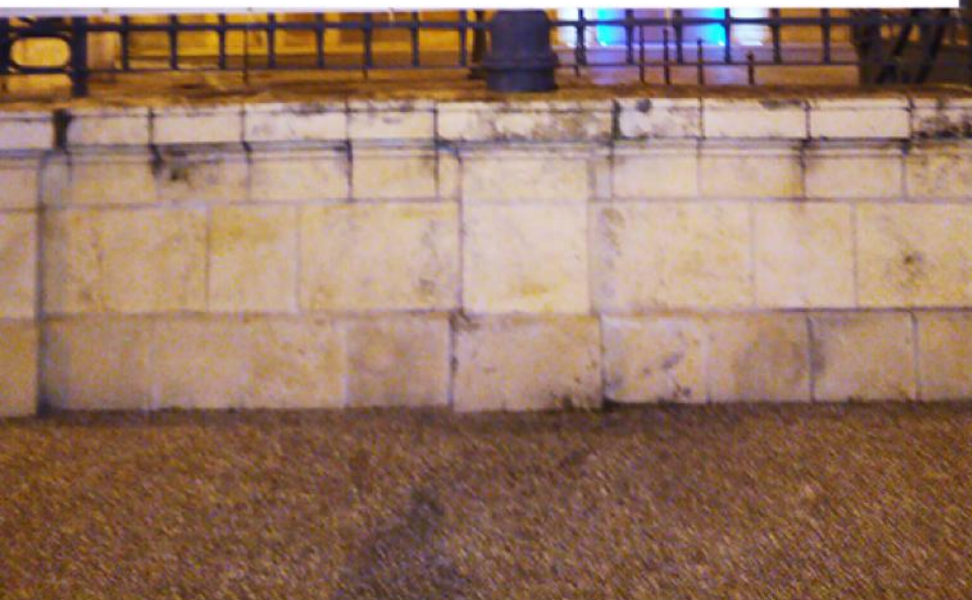

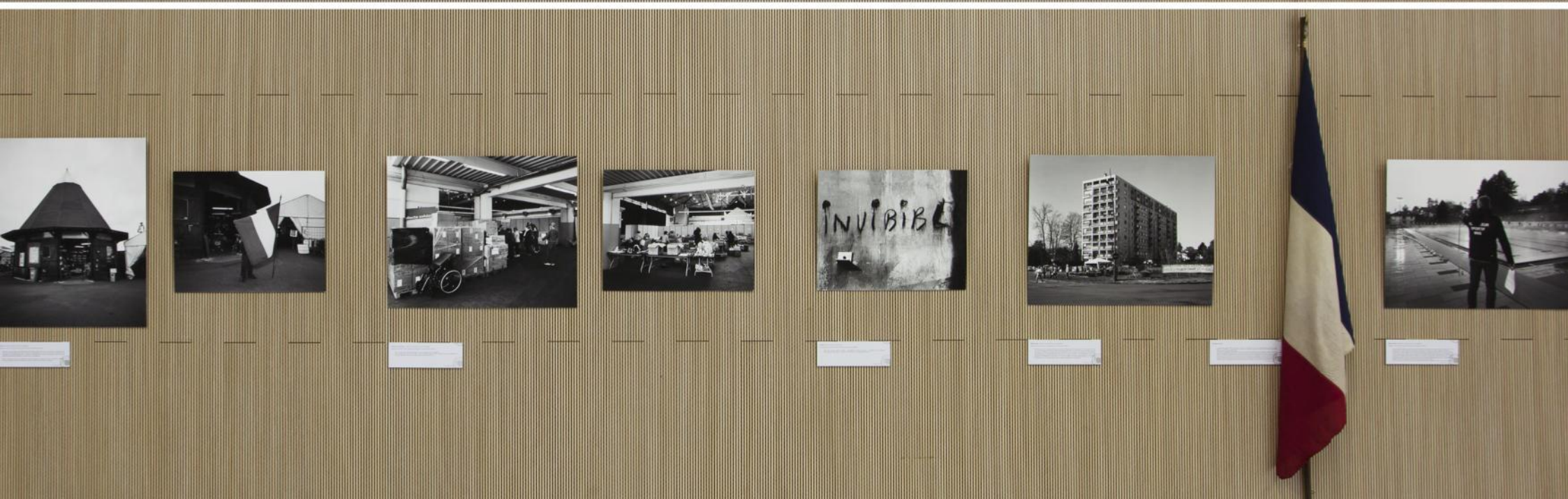

Panorama

The challenge of this project, in collaboration with choreographer Lionel Hoche, lies in transforming urban space through the body. The aim is to invite residents to embrace the city not only as a place of passage or daily use, but as a space for artistic and collective expression. By going beyond the purely utilitarian function of public space, every gesture and every movement becomes a form of urban poetry, a way of reinventing the connection between individuals and their environment.

Spectral City

This project, conducted in collaboration with Dr. Pushpa Arabindoo, associate professor in the Department of Geography at UCL (University College London), is part of her research on urban change in India. I captured the changing city and its inhabitants before their eviction. These images convey the urgency of a present already marked by impending absence, where every gesture and every stone bears the trace of a foretold disappearance. An urban and visual narrative bearing witness to what once was, before everything changed.
